### WAR PRECAUTIONS (COAL) REGULATIONS.

#### NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 8B.

I ALEXANDER POYNTON, Acting Minister of State for the Navy, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by Regulation 8B of the War Precautions (Coal) Regulations, do hereby prohibit the running, on and after the sixteenth day of July, 1919, of electric and cable trams other than trams the property of the State of Victoria—

- (a) on Sundays, and  
(b) on week-days (Monday to Saturday inclusive) on any trip commencing from a terminus after Seven o'clock *post meridiem*,

within the following areas:—

- (i) the area comprised within a radius of fifteen miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne;

- (ii) the area comprised within a radius of ten miles from the Post Office, Ballarat;  
(iii) the area comprised within a radius of ten miles from the Post Office, Bendigo; and  
(iv) the area comprised within a radius of ten miles from the Post Office, Geelong:

Provided that nothing in this Notice shall be deemed to prohibit the running of any tram for the purpose of enabling it to be returned to its shed after Seven o'clock *post meridiem* on week-days.
