No. 10 of 1919.

AN ORDINANCE

Relating to the Appointment of a Deputy
Administrator.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910* and the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910*, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Deputy Administrator Ordinance 1919*. Short title.

2.—(1.) In the event of the Administrator of the Northern Territory or the Acting Administrator being absent from the Northern Territory or unable to perform his duties on account of illness, the Governor-General may appoint a Deputy Administrator who shall have and may exercise all the powers and functions and shall perform all the duties of the Administrator under any Ordinance made under the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910* or under any regulations made under any such Ordinance. Appointment of Deputy Administrator.

(2.) The exercise and performance of such powers, functions and duties shall be in accordance with such instructions as are given to the Deputy Administrator by the Minister.

THE WAR PRECAUTIONS (COAL) REGULATIONS.

Direction as to Wages of Mechanics and Others in New South Wales.

IN pursuance of Regulation 10A of the War Precautions (Coal) Regulations, I, Littleton Ernest Groom, Minister for Works and Railways, acting for and on behalf of the Prime Minister of the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby direct that the rates of wages of the undermentioned persons employed in the production of coal acquired or to be acquired by the Commonwealth under that Regulation in the State of New South Wales shall be the rates respectively set out in the second column hereunder opposite the designation of the persons employed.

Designation of Persons Employed.	Rates to be Paid.
Adult mechanics	The rates prevailing on 1st May, 1919, plus 15 per cent. of such rates
Adult engine-drivers, firemen, motor-drivers, and attendants	The rates prevailing on 1st May, 1919, plus 2s. 7d. per day
Adult labourers assisting mechanics	A minimum wage of 13s. 6d. per day
Boys and youths	The rates prevailing on 1st May, 1919, plus 20 per cent. of such rates

And I declare that such rates of wages shall be payable on and after the fifth day of May, 1919.
