WHEREAS by a Proclamation issued in pursuance of the Quarantine Act 1908-1915, and published in the Gazette of 17th October, 1918, the ports of Fremantle, Adelaide, Melbourne, Sydney, Brisbane, were declared to be first ports of entry for vessels arriving in Australia from the Union of South Africa:

And whereas it is desirable to repeal the said Proclamation:

Now therefore I, Sir Ronald Craufurd Munro Ferguson, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby repeal the said Proclamation.

This Proclamation may be cited as Quarantine Proclamation No. 54.
