INDUSTRIAL BOARD.

VARIATION OF AWARD.

In the matter of the *Industrial Board Ordinances 1922*, and in the matter of an application made by the SECRETARY OF THE A.W.U. RAILWAY WORKERS' INDUSTRY BRANCH, NEW SOUTH WALES.
