AN ORDINANCE

Relating to the Application of Section 22 of the Darwin
Town Council Ordinance 1915-1922.

BE it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Northern Territory Acceptance Act 1910-1919* and the *Northern Territory (Administration) Act 1910* as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Darwin Town Council* short title. Ordinance (No. 2) 1922.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of sub-section (4H) of section twenty-two of the Darwin Town Council Ordinance 1915-1922 a person shall not be disqualified for enrolment for the purposes of the election to be held in the month of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-two on the ground that all amounts due by him by way of general rate in respect of any rateable property have not been paid.
