TERRITORY OF NEW GUINEA.

No. 8 of 1930.

AN ORDINANCE

To amend the Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1929.

BE it ordained by the Deputy of the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *New Guinea Act 1920-1926*, as follows:—

1.—(1.) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Superannuation Ordinance 1930*. Short title and citation.

(2.) The *Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1929* is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3.) The Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance may be cited as the *Superannuation Ordinance 1928-1930*.

2. Section sixteen of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from sub-section (1.) the word "twelve" and inserting in its stead the word "eighteen". Contributions, &c., in respect of past service.
