### ACT OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, that His Excellency the Governor-General, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, assented, on the 17th July, 1931, to the undermentioned Act passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives in Parliament assembled, viz.:-

No. 10 of 1931.—“An Act to make necessary Provision for carrying out a Plan agreed on by the Commonwealth and the States for meeting the grave Financial Emergency existing in Australia, re-establishing Financial Stability, and restoring Industrial and General Prosperity.”

### PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of Australia to wit.  
ISAAC A. ISAACS  
Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the *Financial Emergency Act 1931* it is enacted that the several parts and sections of that Act, other than Part I. and the sections contained therein, shall commence on such dates as are respectively fixed by proclamation:

Now therefore I, Sir Isaac Alfred Isaacs, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby fix the twentieth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-one, as the date upon which the several parts and sections of the said Act, other than Part I. and the sections contained therein, shall commence.

Now therefore I, Sir Isaac Alfred Isaacs, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby order that the several Parts respectively specified in the First Column of the following Schedule and the sections respectively contained in those Parts shall be administered by the Ministers respectively specified in the Second Column of that Schedule.
