#### OUTBREAK OF WAR WITH ITALY.

**I**N a telegram dated 10th June, 8.6 p.m., the Commonwealth Government received official advice from the Secretary of State for Dominion Affairs, London, to the effect that the King of Italy would consider himself at war with Great Britain and France as from midnight 10th June, 1940.

Therefore a state of war exists between His Majesty the King and the King of Italy as from 9 o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Australian Capital Territory, of 11th June, 1940.
