Defence (Special Undertakings) Act 1952.
**DECLARATION OF A SPECIAL DEFENCE
 UNDERTAKING.**

WHEREAS by section six of the *Defence (Special Undertakings) Act 1952* it is provided that a work or undertaking which—

- (a) is being carried out, or is to be carried out, whether within or without Australia, for or in relation to the defence of Australia, or in part for or in relation to the defence of Australia and in part for or in relation to the defence of some other part of the Queen's dominions, or of some other country associated with Australia in resisting or preparing to resist international aggression; and
- (b) is declared by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette* to be a special defence undertaking,

is a special defence undertaking for the purposes of the said Act:

And whereas the carrying out of operations for the testing of long range and atomic weapons at and upon the Long Range Weapons Area at Woomera in the State of South Australia being the area described in the several Declarations referred to in the schedule hereunder is a work which is being carried out and is to be carried out for and in relation to the defence of Australia:

Now, therefore, I, Philip Albert Martin McBride, the Minister of State for Defence, hereby declare the operations for the testing of long range and atomic weapons which are being carried out and are to be carried out at and upon the said Long Range Weapons Area at Woomera in the State of South Australia to be a special defence undertaking.

Declaration made by the Minister of State for Supply and Development under regulation 5 of the Supply and Development (Long Range Weapons) Regulations and published in the *Gazette* dated the fourteenth day of April 1949 at page 964;

Declaration made by the Minister of State for Supply under sub-regulation (1.) of regulation 90 of the Supply and Development Regulations and published in the *Gazette* dated the twentieth day of December 1951 at page 3210; and

Declaration made by the Minister of State for Supply under sub-regulation (1.) of regulation 90 of the Supply and Development Regulations and published in the *Gazette* dated the twelfth day of March 1953 at page 605.

Defence (Special Undertakings) Act 1952.
DECLARATION OF A PROHIBITED AREA.

WHEREAS by section eight of the *Defence (Special Undertakings) Act 1952* it is provided that if it is necessary for the purposes of the defence of the Commonwealth so to do, the Minister may, by notice published in the *Gazette*, declare an area of land or water or an area of land or water (whether or not it belongs to or is used for the purposes of the Queen, the Commonwealth or a State) to be, for the purposes of that Act, a prohibited area:

And whereas it is necessary for the purposes of the defence of the Commonwealth that the area of land referred to in the schedule to this Declaration be declared to be, for the purposes of that Act, a prohibited area:

Now, therefore, I, Philip Albert Martin McBride, the Minister of State for Defence, hereby declare the area of land referred to in the schedule to this Declaration to be, for the purposes of the *Defence (Special Undertakings) Act 1952*, a prohibited area.

THE SCHEDULE.

All that area of land known as the Long Range Weapons Area, Woomera, South Australia being the land described in the following Declarations of a Prohibited Area namely—

Declaration made by the Minister of State for Supply and Development under regulation 5 of the Supply and Development (Long Range Weapons) Regulations and published in the *Gazette* dated the fourteenth day of April 1949 at page 964;

Declaration made by the Minister of State for Supply under sub-regulation (1.) of regulation 90 of the Supply and Development Regulations and published in the *Gazette* dated the twentieth day of December 1951 at page 3210; and

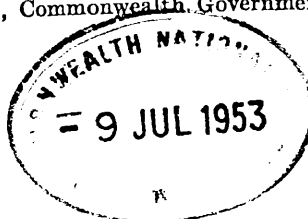
