PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of
Australia to wit.
W. J. SLIM
Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Governor-
General in and over the Common-
wealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1.) of section eighteen of the *Commonwealth Bank Act 1953* it is provided that, in that section, unless the contrary intention appears, the proclaimed date means a date fixed by Proclamation as the date on which the Commonwealth Bank of Australia shall cease to carry on business in its General Banking Division:

Now therefore I, Sir William Joseph Slim, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby fix the third day of December, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, as the date on which the Commonwealth Bank of Australia shall cease to carry on business in its General Banking Division.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Commonwealth this fifteenth day of October, in the year of our Lord, (L.S.) One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, and in the second year of Her Majesty's reign.

HIGH COURT OF AUSTRALIA.

RULE OF COURT.

(As of Friday the 9th day of October, 1953.)

It is ordered as follows:—

1. Sittings of the Court for the transaction of all such business as may be brought before it shall be held during the year 1954 at the places and on the days hereunder mentioned, that is to say—

Melbourne	Thursday, 18th February.
— Hobart	Tuesday, 16th March.
Sydney	Wednesday, 24th March.
Melbourne	Tuesday, 11th May.
— Adelaide	Tuesday, 15th June.
— Brisbane	Monday, 26th July.
Sydney	Tuesday, 17th August.
Melbourne	Tuesday, 14th September.
— Perth	Tuesday, 19th October.
Sydney	Tuesday, 9th November.

2. Causes may be set down for trial on the first day appointed for holding any sitting of the Court, or on any other day appointed by the Chief Justice.

3. No sittings will be held unless there is a substantial amount of business.

4. The winter vacation shall begin on Saturday, 26th June. The summer vacation shall begin on Saturday, 18th December.
