**ELECTION OF A DIVISIONAL REPRESENTATIVE.**

**P**URSUANT to Public Service Regulation 14L, it is hereby notified that an election is to be held of a Divisional Representative of the Fourth Division in the State of New South Wales, to act on Appeal Boards under Sections 55 and 82AA of the abovenamed Act. The elected representative will hold office until 31st October, 1956.

The Public Service Board has fixed Thursday, the 17th December, 1953, as the last date for the receipt of nominations of candidates for election and Wednesday, the 17th March, 1954, as the date for the close of the poll, and nominations of candidates for election and votes for candidates must reach the Returning Officer at the Commonwealth Electoral Office, Sydney, not later than twelve o'clock noon on such dates respectively.

No person shall be eligible for nomination unless he is an officer of the Fourth Division permanently stationed in the State of New South Wales and is entitled to vote at the election.

A nomination shall—

- (a) name the candidate for election, the office held by him and the department in which he is employed, and
- (b) be signed by not less than twenty persons entitled to vote at the election for the Fourth Division in the State of New South Wales.
