PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of
Australia to wit.
W. J. SLIM
Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is provided by section two of the *International Wheat Agreement Act 1953* that that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

And whereas it is provided by sub-section (1.) of section two of the *Wheat Marketing Act 1953* that that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

Now therefore I, Sir William Joseph Slim, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby fix the thirty-first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, as the date on which the *International Wheat Agreement Act 1953* and the *Wheat Marketing Act 1953* shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Commonwealth this thirtieth day of October, in the year of our (L.S.) Lord, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-three, and in the second year of Her Majesty's reign.
