I, NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section nine a of the Customs Tariff 1933-1962, do hereby declare that, on and after the third day of May, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, the rate of duty set out in the column headed "Intermediate Tariff" in the Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1933-1962 (being that Schedule as proposed to be amended by Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the second day of May, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two) in relation to an item in that Schedule the number of which is specified in the Schedule to this Order shall apply to goods included in that item that are the produce or manufacture of a country specified in the Second Schedule to the Customs (Intermediate Tariff) Order No. 11 on the fourteenth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and published in the Gazette on the sixth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.

Customs Act 1901-1960.

CUSTOMS BY-LAWS Nos. 736-737.

I, NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901-1960, hereby make the following By-laws set out in the Schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE.

By-law No. 736.

Item 44 (c)(1).

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 736.
2. Item 44 (c)(1) of the Customs Tariff 1933-1962, as proposed to be altered, applies to Cocoa butter for use in the manufacture of chocolate or confectionery, under security.
3. By-law No. 13, published in Gazette No. 23, dated 10th March, 1961, is revoked.

By-law No. 737.

Item 449 (A)(1).

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 737.
2. By-law No. 203, published in Gazette No. 23, dated 10th March, 1961, as amended, is further amended by adding to the list of goods to which Tariff Item 449 (A)(1) applies, under the heading "Yarns" the following:—

Triacetate or in chief part by weight of triacetate.
