#### CUSTOMS BY-LAW No. 791.

**I** NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901-1960, hereby make the following by-law.

By-law No. 791.

Item 105 (D)(4).

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 791.
2. By-law No. 35, published in Gazette No. 23, dated 10th March, 1961, as amended, is further amended by—

- (a) deleting from the list of Woven piece goods, &c., to which Tariff Item 105 (D)(4) applies, the reference to "In the grey, &c."
- (b) adding to the list of Woven piece goods, &c., to which Tariff Item 105 (D)(4) applies, the following:—

In the grey (i.e. both "in the gum" and "boiled off", weighing 6 ounces or more per square yard, for use in the manufacture of printed furnishing fabrics, under security.

IN pursuance of section 273EA of the Customs Act 1901-1960, I, Allen Fairhall, Minister of State for Supply, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Customs and Excise, hereby give notice that I intend, within seven sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of the publication of this notice in the Gazette, to propose in the Parliament—

- (a) that the Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1933-1962 be amended as set out in the Schedule to this notice; and  
 (b) that the proposed Customs Tariff alteration referred to in this notice operate on and from the twenty-sixth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.
