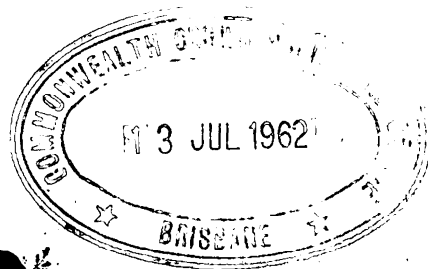

Customs Act 1901-1960.
CUSTOMS BY-LAWS Nos. 806-807.

I NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901-1960, hereby make the following By-laws set out in the Schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE.

By-law No. 806.

Item 330 (A) (1).

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 806.
2. This by-law shall take effect from 6th July, 1962.
3. Item 330 (A) (1) of the Customs Tariff 1933-1962, as proposed to be altered, applies to—
 Latex, otherwise classifiable under Tariff Item 330 (A) (3).
 Natural or synthetic rubber, otherwise classifiable under Tariff Item 330 (A) (5), provided entered for home consumption on or before 31st December, 1962.
 Silicone rubber, otherwise classifiable under Tariff Item 330 (A) (2).

4. By-law No. 615, published in Gazette No. 13, dated 1st March, 1962, is revoked.

By-law No. 807.

Item 330 (B) (1).

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 807.
2. This by-law shall take effect from 6th July, 1962.
3. Item 330 (B) (1) of the Customs Tariff 1933-1962, as proposed to be altered, applies to—
 Compounded latex, otherwise classifiable under Tariff Item 330 (B) (3).
 Compounded natural or synthetic rubber, otherwise classifiable under Tariff Item 330 (B) (5), provided entered for home consumption on or before 31st December, 1962.
4. By-law No. 616, published in Gazette No. 13, dated 1st March, 1962, is revoked.

NOTICE (No. 29) OF TARIFF PROPOSALS.

IN pursuance of section 273EA of the Customs Act 1901-1960, I, Allen Fairhall, Minister of State for Supply, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Customs and Excise, hereby give notice that I intend, within seven sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of the publication of this notice in the Gazette, to propose in the Parliament—

- (a) that the Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1933-1962 be amended as set out in the Schedule to this notice; and
- (b) that the proposed Customs Tariff alteration referred to in this notice operate on and from the sixth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.
