AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

Companies Ordinance 1962.

I, GORDON FREETH the Minister of State for the Interior, acting for and on behalf of the Attorney-General, declare hereby

(a) in pursuance of sub-section (3.) of section 318 of the Companies Ordinance 1962 of the Australian Capital Territory, each of the following States, to wit, New South Wales, Victoria and Queensland, to be a proclaimed State for the purposes of that section;

(b) in pursuance of paragraph (b) of sub-section (5.) of section 348 of the said Ordinance, each of the following three classes of corporations to be a class of corporations of a kind the same or substantially the same as exempt proprietary companies under the Companies Ordinance 1962:

- (i) corporations incorporated in the State of New South Wales which are exempt proprietary companies under the law of New South Wales;
- (ii) corporations incorporated in the State of Victoria which are exempt proprietary companies under the law of Victoria; and

(iii) corporations incorporated in the State of Queensland which are exempt proprietary companies under the law of Queensland.

(c) in pursuance of paragraph (c) of sub-section (5.) of section 348 of the said Ordinance, each of the following three classes of corporations to be a class of corporations of a kind the same or substantially the same as proprietary companies under the Companies Ordinance 1962:

- (i) corporations incorporated in the State of South Australia which are proprietary companies under the law of South Australia;
- (ii) corporations incorporated in the State of Western Australia which are proprietary companies under the law of Western Australia; and
- (iii) corporations incorporated in the State of Tasmania which are proprietary companies under the law of Tasmania.
