**W**HEREAS it is provided by section two of the Explosives Act 1961 that that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

Now therefore I, Sir Reginald Alexander Dallas Brooks, the Administrator aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby fix the 30th day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, as the date on which that Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth this 30th day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, and in the eleventh year of Her Majesty's reign.

## NOTICE (No. 36) OF TARIFF PROPOSALS.

IN pursuance of section 273EA of the Customs Act 1901-1960, I, Allen Fairhall, Minister of State for Supply, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Customs and Excise, hereby give notice that I intend, within seven sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of the publication of this notice in the Gazette, to propose in the Parliament—

- (a) that the Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1933-1962 be amended as set out in the Schedule to this notice; and  
 (b) that the proposed Customs Tariff alteration referred to in this notice operate on and from the thirty-first day of July, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.
