WHEREAS it is provided by sub-section (1) of section two of the Navigation Act 1958, that the sections of that Act, other than sections one and two, shall come into operation on such dates as are respectively fixed by Proclamation:

Now therefore I, Sir Reginald Alexander Dallas Brooks, the Administrator aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby fix the 21st day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, as the date on which sections twenty-seven, seven-eight and eighty-two of that Act shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth this 21st day of August, in the year of our Lord, (L.S.) One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, and in the eleventh year of Her Majesty's reign.
