CUSTOMS (INTERMEDIATE TARIFF) ORDER No. 83.

I NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section nine A of the Customs Tariff 1933-1962, do hereby declare that, on and after the twenty-fourth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, the rate of duty set out in the column headed "Intermediate Tariff" in the Schedule to the Customs Tariff

1933-1962 (being that Schedule as proposed to be amended by Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the twenty-third day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two) in relation to an item in that Schedule the number of which is specified in the Schedule to this Order shall apply to goods included in that item that are the produce or manufacture of a country specified in the Second Schedule to the Customs (Intermediate Tariff) Order No. 11 made on the fourteenth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and published in the Gazette on the sixth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.
