Customs Act 1901-1960.

CUSTOMS BY-LAW No. 955.

I NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901-1960, hereby make the following By-law.

By-law No. 955.

Item 449 (A) (2).

1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 955.

2. By-law No. 204, published in Gazette No. 23, dated 10th March, 1961, as amended, is further amended by:—

(a) deleting from the list of goods to which Tariff Item 449 (A) (2) applies, under the heading "Drugs and Chemicals, &c.", the reference to "Urea, otherwise classifiable, &c.".

(b) adding to the list of goods to which Tariff Item 449 (A) (2) applies, under the heading "Drugs and Chemicals, &c.", the following:—

Urea, otherwise classifiable under Tariff Item 280 (F), for use as a fertilizer, under security.

CUSTOMS TARIFF (PRIMAGE DUTIES) ORDER No. 112.

I NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of the Customs Tariff (Primage Duties) 1934-1958, do hereby exempt from primage duty, on and after the eighth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, the following goods:—

Goods covered by item 106 (G) (2), 200, 281 (M), 338 (D), 403 (A) (1) (a), 404 or 464 (B) (1) (a) in the Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1933-1962 as proposed to be amended by Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the seventh day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two.

I NORMAN HENRY DENHAM HENTY, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section nine A of the Customs Tariff 1933-1962, do declare that, on and after the eighth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two, the rate of duty set out in the Column headed "Intermediate Tariff" in the Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1933-1962 (being that Schedule as proposed to be amended by Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the seventh day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-two) in relation to an item in the Schedule the number of which is specified in the Schedule to this Order shall apply to goods included in that item that are the produce or manufacture of a country specified in the Second Schedule to the Customs (Intermediate Tariff) Order No. 11 made on the fourteenth day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and published in the Gazette on the sixth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine.
