PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of
Australia to wit
CASEY
Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Governor-General
in and over the Commonwealth of
Australia.

WHEREAS by sub-section (2.) of section 2 of the Defence Forces Retirement Benefits Act (No. 3) 1968 it is provided that sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 20, 21, 22 and 23 of that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

NOW THEREFORE I, Richard Gardiner, Baron Casey, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby fix the thirty-first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, as the date on which sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 13, 20, 21, 22 and 23 of the Defence Forces Retirement Benefits Act (No. 3) 1968 shall come into operation.

GIVEN under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth this 23rd day of January, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and in the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's reign.
