NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PROPOSE CUSTOMS TARIFF ALTERATIONS

NOTICE No. 2 (1969)

IN pursuance of section 273EA of the Customs Act 1901-1968, I, MALCOLM FOX SCOTT, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, hereby give notice that it is intended, within seven sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of the publication of this notice in the Gazette, to propose in the Parliament a Customs Tariff alteration in accordance with the particulars specified in the Schedule to this notice and operating on and from the twenty-fourth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine.
