## CUSTOMS TARIFF 1966-1969

### Section 23

#### Substitutes and Imitations Notice No. 18

I, MALCOLM FOX SCOTT, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by Section 23 of the Customs Tariff 1966-1969 and all other enabling powers:

- (a) declare that I am of the opinion that goods of a kind specified in the first column of the table hereunder—
- (i) are a substitute for goods of another kind specified in the second column of that table opposite those goods;
  - (ii) are intended to be or can be used as a substitute for goods of another kind specified in the second column of that table opposite those goods;
  - (iii) can be used for any purpose for which goods of another kind specified in the second column of that table opposite those goods can be used; or
  - (iv) are an imitation of goods of another kind specified in the second column of that table opposite those goods; and
- (b) direct that the duty in respect of goods specified in the first column of the table hereunder is the duty that would be applicable in respect of them, if they were goods of the kind specified in the second column of that table opposite those goods.

2. In this notice 'First Schedule' means Part II. of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1969.

3. Unless the context otherwise requires in this notice in ascertaining whether goods fall within the terms of a reference or whether a reference applies to goods, regard shall be had to:

- (a) the Rules for the Interpretation of the First Schedule set out in Part I. of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1969; and
- (b) the notes to a Division of Part II. of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1969 or to a Chapter of such a Division that has application to the goods under their Tariff classification in Part II. of that First Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1969.

4. This notice may be cited as Substitutes and Imitations Notice No. 18 and, subject to the next succeeding paragraph, shall take effect from the date of publication in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette.

5. This notice does not apply to goods that:

- (a) are—
  - (i) on firm order overseas on or before 4 November 1969; and
  - (ii) shipped to Australia on or before 31 December 1969 and entered for home consumption within 21 days after importation; or

(b) are—

- (i) in bond in Australia on 4 November 1969; and
- (ii) entered for home consumption on or before 5 December 1969.

#### The Table

First column	Second column
Sheetings (sometimes known as 'percale') being fabrics:	Cotton sheetings falling within sub-paragraph 55.09.329 in the First Schedule.
(a) to which paragraph 55.09.39 in the First Schedule applies;	
(b) that but for their weight per square yard would fall within paragraph 55.09.32 in that Schedule;	
(c) that are of a construction that the sum of the number of ends (warp) per inch and the number of picks (weft) per inch is 150 or exceeds 150; and	
(d) are for use in the making up of bed sheets, pillow cases or bolster cases.

### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PROPOSE CUSTOMS TARIFF ALTERATION

#### NOTICE No. 12 (1969)

IN pursuance of section 273EA of the Customs Act 1901-1968, I, MALCOLM FOX SCOTT, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, hereby give notice that it is intended, within seven sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of the publication of this notice in the Gazette, to propose in the Parliament a Customs Tariff alteration in accordance with the particulars specified in the Schedule to this notice and operating on and from the seventh day of November, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine.

#### AMENDMENT OF PART II. OF THE FIRST SCHEDULE TO THE CUSTOMS TARIFF 1966-1969

Omit sub-item 28.17.1, insert the following sub-item:—

"28.17.1 - Sodium hydroxide .. .. 55% 45%".
