CUSTOMS ACT 1901

CUSTOMS (IMPORT LICENSING) REGULATIONS EXCEPTION NOTICE NO. M69

I, BARRY OWEN JONES, Minister for Science, Customs and Small Business, in pursuance of the power conferred upon me under Regulation 17 of the Customs (Import Licensing) Regulations, do hereby:

- (a) revoke all subsisting exceptions made in pursuance of that regulation; and
- (b) except from the application of those regulations the goods specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

For the purposes of this Notice:

"Customs Tariff Act" means the Customs Tariff Act 1987 as amended from time to time;

"Schedule 3" means Schedule 3 to the Customs Tariff Act.

"Schedule 4" means Schedule 4 to the Customs Tariff Act.

"parts" means used, secondhand or disposals parts.

This Notice shall take effect on and from the First day of July 1989.
