FOOD STANDARDS CODE

(AMENDMENT NO. 3)

1. Preamble

The amendments set forth in the Schedule below are amendments to the National Health and Medical Research Council Food Standards Code (hereinafter called 'the Code') which was published in the Commonwealth of Australia Gazette, No. P27, on 27 August 1987, and which has been amended from time to time.

The Schedule contains amendments adopted by the National Food Standards Council in August 1989.

2. Title

These amendments may be collectively added as 'Amendment No. 3' to the Code.

3. Commencement

These amendments to the Code will commence on the sixteenth day of October 1989.

SCHEDULE

1. The Preliminary Provisions are amended by inserting after the definition of 'component' in clause 5 the following definition:

"'nutrition information panel' means a panel in accordance with clause A1 (13);".

2. Standard A1 is amended by:

- (a) omitting subparagraph (3)(d)(i) and substituting the following subparagraph:

'(i) carbonated water, mineralised water, soda water and mineral water;';

- (b) omitting clause (4) and substituting the following clause:

"(4)(a) The label on or attached to a package containing food shall include a statement that identifies the country in which the food was made or produced.

(b) If the label on or attached to a package containing food includes:

(i) a statement that identifies the country in which the food was packed for retail sale; and

(ii) if any of the ingredients of the food does not originate in the country in which the food was packed for retail sale, a statement:

(A) identifying the country or countries of origin of the ingredients of the food; or

(B) to the effect that the food is made from ingredients imported into that country or from local and imported ingredients, as the case requires;

the label shall be taken to comply with paragraph (a).

(c) The material included on a label under this clause may include a comment on or explanation of that material.

(d) Where the name and address of the manufacturer are set out on the label and the address contains the name of the country in which the food was made or produced, the name and address shall be taken to satisfy the requirements of paragraph (a).

(e) In this clause, 'ingredients' does not include food additives.";

(c) adding at the end of paragraph (5)(b) the following subparagraph:

"(vi) Where the composition of a food may be subject to minor variations by the substitution of an ingredient which falls within a class listed in paragraph (f) of this clause with another ingredient performing a similar function, the label will satisfy the labelling requirements of this Standard if it lists both of those ingredients by using a statement in the following form '(name of ingredient) or (name of substitute ingredient)' or in a similar form.";

(d) omitting clause (11);

(e) inserting after clause (28) the following clause:

"(29) The label on or attached to a package containing a food to which polydextrose has been added otherwise than as a humectant shall include the statement 'EXCESS CONSUMPTION MAY HAVE A LAXATIVE EFFECT' in standard type of 3 mm.";

(f) inserting in appropriate alphabetical order in Part 1 of the Schedule:

'Propylene glycol mono- and di-esters 477';

(g) inserting in appropriate numerical order in Part 2 of the Schedule:

'Propylene glycol mono- and di-esters 477'.

3. Standard A3 is amended by inserting in the Schedule after the item relating to 'Mixtures consisting mainly of skim milk powder for use in the preparation of liquid foods' the following item:

'Non-dairy dips with a pH of less than 4.5

Benzoic acid
in proportion not
exceeding 700 mg/kg'.

4. Standard A7 is amended by:

- (a) inserting in columns 2 and 3 of the table in clause 4, opposite to the item relating to 'Ascorbic acid, erythorbic acid, their sodium salts or a mixture of these', the following:

'Canned fruit that is not in
direct contact with tin 400 mg/kg';

- (b) inserting after clause (4) the following clause:

'(4A) Where ascorbic acid, erythorbic acid, a sodium salt of those acids or a mixture of those substances is used in a food as an antioxidant, the label on or attached to a package containing that food shall not contain any reference to ascorbic acid, erythorbic acid, a sodium salt of those acids or a mixture of those substances other than in:

- (a) the statement of ingredients; or
(b) the statement required by clause A7(5).'

5. Standard A8 is amended by:

- (a) inserting in paragraph (2)(a) 'or its sodium or calcium salt' after 'saccharin';

- (b) inserting after clause (5) the following clauses:

"(5A) Cocoa based drinks or drink mixes, coffee based drinks or drink mixes, dessert mixes, fruit yoghurt or fruit yoghurt products, skim milk based drinks or drink mixes may contain aspartame to a proportion not exceeding 5 g/kg, only if the energy value of such a food, when it contains aspartame, is at least 25% less than the energy value of the typical form of that food that does not contain aspartame.

"(5B) The label on or attached to a package containing a food referred to in clause (5A) to which aspartame has been added shall include a statement along the following lines:

'This [name of food] has an energy value of [energy value of food per 100 g or 100 mL] which is [percentage of reduction] less than the energy value of typical [name of food] that does not contain aspartame.'";

- (c) omitting paragraph (6)(a) and substituting the following paragraph:

"(a) the words 'ARTIFICIALLY SWEETENED';".

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6. Standard A10 is amended by inserting in Group IV of Table 1 in clause (3):

'Propylene glycol mono- and di-esters'

before:

'Sorbitan monostearate'.

7. Standard A11 is amended by inserting in the Schedule in Columns 1 and 2 respectively and in alphabetical order the following additives and references:

'Calcium saccharin	FCC p.62
Propylene glycol mono- and di-esters	FCC p.257
Ethyl vanillin	FCC p.378
Sodium saccharin	FCC p.297
Stannous chloride	FCC p.312
Vanillin	FCC p.418'.

8. Standard A12 is amended by:

- (a) omitting from the table in clause (2) the item relating Tin and substituting the following item:

'Tin	Foods not packed in direct contact with tin	50.0
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Any of the following canned foods in direct contact with tin:

Asparagus	250.0
Fruits	250.0
Fruit juices	250.0
Green beans	250.0
Tomato products as specified in Standard F2	250.0
Foods packed in tomato containing medium	200.0
All other foods	150.0';

- (b) omitting from clause (2) 'Food' (first occurring) and substituting 'Subject to clause (2A), food';
- (c) inserting after clause (2) the following clause:

'(2A) A maximum permitted concentration of a metal specified in the table in clause (2) does not apply to carbonated water, soda water or mineralised water, or to mineral water, if a maximum concentration of that metal is specified in Standard O3 or O8 in relation to that food.'

9. Standard A13 is amended by inserting after clause (5) the following clause:

"(5A) (a) Packages of food may contain sachets of reduced iron powder for the purpose of absorbing oxygen.

(b) Sachets specified in paragraph (a) of this clause shall have at least one face with a surface area of not less than 10 cm², and may also contain one or more of the following:

- (i) calcium chloride;
- (ii) calcium hydroxide;
- (iii) carbon, activated;
- (iv) gypsum;
- (v) iron oxide;
- (vi) magnesium hydroxide;
- (vii) magnesium stearate;
- (viii) perlite;
- (ix) salt;
- (x) talc;
- (xi) water;
- (xii) zeolite.

(c) Such a sachet shall be labelled, in standard type, with the words 'OXYGEN ABSORBER', or with words having a similar intent, and those words shall be followed by the words, in standard type, 'DO NOT EAT CONTENTS' and 'CONTAINS IRON POWDER'."

10. Schedule 1 to Standard A14 is amended by:

- (a) inserting in appropriate alphabetical order in Columns 2 and 3 respectively of the item relating to Bitertanol:

'0.3 beans, except broad bean and soya bean' and
'0.3 pulses';

- (b) omitting from Columns 2 and 3 of the item relating to Chlordane '0.05 fat of meat' and inserting in appropriate alphabetical order:

'0.2 mammalian meat (in the fat)';

- (c) inserting in appropriate alphabetical order in Columns 2 and 3 respectively of the item relating to Deltamethrin:

- '5 apples';
- (i) inserting in appropriate alphabetical order in Columns 2 and 3 respectively of the item relating to Dithiocarbamates (excluding propineb):

'0.5 meat (except poultry)' and
'0.2 milk';
- (j) inserting in appropriate alphabetical order in Columns 2 and 3 respectively of the item relating to Ethephon:

11. Standard B4 is amended by:

- (a) inserting after clause (1) the following clause:
- '(1A) Aspartame may be added to dessert mix as specified in Standard A8.';
- (b) inserting after clause (3) the following clause:
- '(4) Custard mix, dessert mix, custard powder or blanc mange powder, when made up as directed, may contain polydextrose to a level not exceeding 140 g/kg.'.

12. Standard C1 is amended by:

- (a) omitting from sub-subparagraph (5)(b)(ii)(F) 'not more than 1.3 g/kg of';
- (b) adding at the end of sub-subparagraph (8)(d)(i)(B) 'when used as an antioxidant';
- (c) omitting paragraph (8)(g);
- (d) adding at the end of sub-subparagraph (9)(d)(i)(B) 'when used as an antioxidant';
- (e) omitting paragraph (9)(g);
- (f) adding at the end of subparagraph (10)(f)(ii) 'when used as an antioxidant';
- (g) omitting paragraph (10)(i);
- (h) omitting clause (14);
- (i) adding at the end of sub-subparagraph (15)(c)(i)(E) 'when used as an antioxidant';
- (j) omitting paragraph (15)(e).

13. Standard C4 is inserted after Standard C3 as follows:

"C4 - MEAT PIE AND MEAT AND VEGETABLE PIE

Interpretation

1. In this Standard:

'meat pie' means a pie consisting of a cooked meat filling that is encased wholly or substantially in pastry, but does not include a sausage roll or a pastie;

'meat and vegetable pie' means a pie consisting of a cooked meat and cooked vegetable filling that is encased wholly or partly in pastry, but does not include a sausage roll or a pastie;

'vegetables' includes mushrooms.

Requirements relating to composition

2. (1) A meat pie that weighs more than 70 g shall contain not less than 250 g/kg of meat.

(2) A meat and vegetable pie shall contain:

- (a) not less than 125 g/kg of meat; and
- (b) not less than 250 g/kg of total meat and vegetables.

(3) Meat in a meat pie or a meat and vegetable pie shall not contain more than 333 g/kg of fat.

(4) Any one or more of the following substances may be added to the filling of a meat pie or a meat and vegetable pie:

- (a) herbs and herb extracts;
- (b) spices and spice extracts;
- (c) salt;
- (d) flavourings;
- (e) flavour enhancers;
- (f) water;
- (g) caramel;
- (h) modifying agents specified in Group I or IV of Table 1 in clause A10 (3);
- (j) other foods.

Labelling requirements

3. (1) The words 'meat pie' and 'meat and vegetable pie' are not prescribed names.

(2) The appropriate designation in a label on or attached to a package containing a meat pie or a meat and vegetable pie shall be in standard type of 3 mm.

(3) Where more than one species of meat is declared in the appropriate designation in a label on or attached to a package containing a meat pie or a meat and vegetable pie or on a notice displayed in accordance with sub-clause (4), the name of the species of meat that is present in the greater or greatest proportion must appear before the name or names of the other or those other species in the appropriate designation.

(4) Where a person exposes meat pies or meat and vegetable pies for sale individually and otherwise than in packages, the person shall cause the appropriate designation in standard type of 9 mm to be displayed at the premises at which they are so exposed for sale."

14. Standard D1 is amended by:

- (a) adding at the end of subparagraph (3)(b)(ii) 'when used as an antioxidant';
- (b) omitting paragraph (3)(c);
- (c) adding at the end of subparagraph (10)(a)(ii) when used as an antioxidant';
- (d) omitting paragraph (10)(b).

15. Standard F2 is amended by omitting subparagraph (1)(b)(iii) and substituting the following subparagraph:

'(iii) not more than 350 mg/kg of calcium chloride, calcium sulphate or calcium citrate, calculated as calcium.'

16. Standard G1 is amended by

- (a) omitting from sub-subparagraph (2)(a)(ii)(A) 'an acid value of not more than 2.0';
- (b) omitting from sub-subparagraphs (2)(e)(ii)(A), (2)(f)(ii)(A) and (2)(g)(ii)(A) 'an acid value of not more than 0.4';
- (c) omitting from sub-subparagraphs (2)(i)(ii)(A) and (2)(k)(ii)(A) 'an acid value of not more than 0.5';
- (d) omitting from sub-subparagraph (2)(j)(ii)(A) 'an acid value of not more than 1.0'.

17. Standard G3 is amended by omitting from paragraph (2)(a) 'That name' and substituting 'Unless the label includes a nutrition information panel, that name'.

18. Standard H1 is amended by:

- (a) inserting after clause (10) the following clause:

'(10A) Pasteurised milk, homogenised pasteurised milk, ultra heat treated milk or sterilised milk may be prepared from milk using one or more of the following processes:

- (a) the removal of cream;
- (b) the addition of cream;
- (c) the addition of one or more of skim milk, skim milk powder and skim milk concentrate.'

- (b) inserting at the end of clause (14) the following:

'Provided that pasteurised milk, homogenised pasteurised milk, ultra heat treated milk or sterilised milk that has been prepared in accordance with clause (10A) of this Standard shall not be taken to be modified milk for the purposes of this clause.'

19. Standard H2 is amended by:

- (a) omitting from paragraph (11)(a) 'and thickened reduced cream' and substituting ',thickened reduced cream and thickened light cream';
- (b) omitting from paragraph (11)(a) 'or, as the case may be, pasteurised reduced cream' and substituting ',pasteurised reduced cream or, as the case may be, pasteurised light cream';
- (c) inserting after paragraph 11(c) the following paragraphs:
 - '(ca) Thickened light cream shall contain not less than 180 g/kg of milk fat.
 - (cb) Sugar may be added to thickened light cream.'
- (d) omitting from paragraph (11)(d) "or, as the case may be, 'THICKENED REDUCED CREAM'" and substituting ", 'THICKENED REDUCED CREAM' or 'THICKENED LIGHT CREAM' as the case may be,";
- (e) omitting from paragraph (11)(e) 'and ultra heat treated thickened reduced cream' and substituting ',ultra heat treated thickened reduced cream and ultra heat treated thickened light cream';

(f) omitting paragraph (15)(a) and substituting the following paragraph:

'(15)(a) Ultra heat treated cream, ultra heat treated rich cream, ultra heat treated light cream, ultra heat treated extra light cream, ultra heat treated reduced cream, ultra heat treated thickened cream, ultra heat treated thickened reduced cream, ultra heat treated thickened light cream and ultra heat treated whipped thickened reduced cream are the products prepared from cream, rich cream, light cream, extra light cream, reduced cream, thickened cream, thickened reduced cream, thickened light cream or, as the case may be, whipped thickened reduced cream that has been treated at a temperature of not less than 133°C by direct heating with steam or indirect heating to ensure preservation and immediately thereafter aseptically packed in hermetically sealed packages.'

(g) omitting from subparagraph (15)(b)(ii) 'or thickened reduced cream' and substituting ',thickened reduced cream or thickened light cream'.

20. Standard H5 is amended by omitting from paragraph (3)(a) 'man' and substituting 'people'.

21. Standard H7 is amended by omitting paragraph (3)(b).

22. Standard H8 is amended by:

(a) inserting after sub-subparagraph (2)(b)(iii)(A) the following sub-subparagraph:

'(AA) polydextrose in total proportion of not more than 50 g/kg;'

(b) inserting after sub-subparagraph (3)(b)(iii)(F) the following sub-subparagraph:

'(G) aspartame as specified in Standard A8;'

23. Standard J3 is amended by:

(a) inserting in subparagraph (2)(b)(i) 'not being mango chutney -' before 'shall';

(b) inserting after subparagraph (2)(b)(i) the following subparagraph:

'(ia) being mango chutney - shall contain not less than 400 g/kg of fruit;'

24. Standard K3 is amended by:

- (a) adding at the end of sub-subparagraph (3)(a)(ii) 'when used as an antioxidant';
- (b) omitting paragraph (3)(b).

25. Standard L1 is amended by:

- (a) inserting after sub-subparagraph (1)(b)(ii)(C) the following sub-subparagraph:
 - '(CA) polydextrose in total proportion of not more than 110 g/kg;';
- (b) inserting after sub-subparagraph (3)(b)(ii)(C) the following sub-subparagraph:
 - '(CA) polydextrose in total proportion of not more than 110 g/kg;';
- (c) omitting 'and' at the end of subparagraph 5(b)(iii);
- (d) omitting ':' at the end of subparagraph 5(b)(iv) and substituting ';' ;
- (e) inserting after subparagraph (5)(b)(iv) the following subparagraph:
 - '(v) polydextrose in total proportion of not more than 110 g/kg;'.
- (f) inserting after sub-subparagraph (7)(d)(ii)(C) the following sub-subparagraph:
 - '(CA) polydextrose in total proportion of not more than 110 g/kg;'.

26. Standard O3 is repealed and the following Standard is substituted:

"O3 - CARBONATED WATER, SODA WATER AND MINERALISED WATER

Interpretation

1. In this Standard:

- 'carbonated water' means water that has been impregnated with carbon dioxide under pressure;
- 'mineralised water' means water, whether or not impregnated with carbon dioxide under pressure, to which mineral salts have been added;

'soda water' means:

- (a) carbonated water; or
- (b) carbonated water to which carbonate or bicarbonate salts of sodium or potassium have been added.

Requirements relating to composition

2. (1) Chloride, sulphate, carbonate or bicarbonate salts of any of the following metals may be added to mineralised water:

- (a) sodium;
- (b) potassium;
- (c) magnesium;
- (d) calcium;
- (e) iron.

Metals and contaminants

3. (1) Mineralised water, soda water or carbonated water shall not contain more than:

- (a) 0.05 mg/L of arsenic;
- (b) 1.0 mg/L of barium;
- (c) 30 mg/L of borate (expressed as H_3BO_3);
- (d) 0.005 mg/L of cadmium;
- (e) 0.1 mg/L of chlorine, free;
- (f) 0.05 mg/L of chromium;
- (g) 1.0 mg/L of copper;
- (h) 0.1 mg/L of cyanide (expressed as CN^-);
- (j) 1.5 mg/L of fluoride (expressed as F^-);
- (k) 0.05 mg/L of lead;
- (m) 2.0 mg/L of manganese;
- (n) 0.001 mg/L of mercury;
- (o) 45 mg/L of nitrate (expressed as NO_3^-);
- (p) 0.1 mg/L of nitrite (expressed as NO_2^-);
- (q) 0.01 mg/L of selenium;
- (r) 0.05 mg/L of sulphide (expressed as H_2S);
- (s) 5.0 mg/L of zinc.

(2) Mineralised water or soda water shall not have a chemical oxygen demand (expressed as O_2 when assessed by the dichromate digestion method) exceeding 3 mg/L.

Labelling requirements

4. (1) The label on or attached to a package containing mineralised water, soda water or carbonated water shall include the prescribed name 'MINERALISED WATER', 'SODA WATER' or 'CARBONATED WATER', as the case may be, in standard type of 3 mm.

(2) The label on or attached to a package containing mineralised water shall also include:

- (a) if carbon dioxide has not been added to the mineralised water, the word 'STILL' or the words 'NON CARBONATED' in standard type of the same size as the prescribed name; and
- (b) a statement in standard type of typical analysis of the mineralised water which expresses its mineral constituents in terms of their ions in descending order of concentration in mg/L."

27. Standard O8 is inserted after Standard O7 as follows:

"O8 - MINERAL WATER

Interpretation

1. In this Standard:

'mineral water' means ground water obtained from subterranean water-bearing strata that, in its natural state, contains soluble matter.

Requirements relating to treatments

2. (1) Mineral water may be subjected to one or more of the following treatments:

- (a) separation from unstable constituents by decantation or filtration or by both decantation and filtration;
- (b) chlorination followed by dechlorination;
- (c) aeration;
- (d) deaeration;
- (e) carbonation;
- (f) decarbonation;
- (g) ultraviolet sterilisation;
- (h) ozone treatment;
- (j) pasteurisation.

Metals and contaminants

3. (1) Mineral water shall not contain more than:

- (a) 0.05 mg/L of arsenic;
- (b) 1.0 mg/L of barium;
- (c) 30 mg/L of borate (expressed as H_3BO_3);
- (d) 0.005 mg/L of cadmium;
- (e) 0.1 mg/L of chlorine, free;
- (f) 0.05 mg/L of chromium;
- (g) 1.0 mg/L of copper;
- (h) 0.1 mg/L of cyanide (expressed as CN^-);
- (j) 1.5 mg/L of fluoride (expressed as F^-);
- (k) 0.05 mg/L of lead;
- (m) 2.0 mg/L of manganese;

- (n) 0.001 mg/L of mercury;
- (o) 45 mg/L of nitrate (expressed as NO_3^-);
- (p) 0.1 mg/L of nitrite (expressed as NO_2^-);
- (q) 0.01 mg/L of selenium;
- (r) 0.05 mg/L of sulphide (expressed as H_2S);
- (s) 5.0 mg/L of zinc.

(2) Mineral water shall not have a chemical oxygen demand (expressed as O_2 when assessed by the dichromate digestion method) exceeding 3 mg/L.

(3) The radium content of mineral water shall not exceed 1.0 Bq/L.

(4) Mineral water shall comply with the requirements of Standard A14 so far as those requirements relate to water.

Microbiological requirements

4. (1) Mineral water shall not contain:

- (a) more than 10 coliforms per 100 mL; or
- (b) Escherichia coli in any 100 mL sample.

(2) Mineral water shall have a standard plate count not exceeding 100 micro-organisms per mL.

Labelling requirements

5. (1) The label on or attached to a package containing mineral water shall include:

- (a) the prescribed name 'MINERAL WATER' or, if carbon dioxide has not been added to the mineral water, the prescribed name 'MINERAL WATER' or the prescribed name 'SPRING WATER', in standard type of 3 mm;
- (b) if carbon dioxide has not been added to, and is not naturally occurring in, the mineral water, the word 'STILL' or the words 'NON CARBONATED' in standard type of the same size as the prescribed name; and
- (c) a statement in standard type of typical analysis of the mineral water which expresses its mineral constituents in terms of their ions in descending order of concentration in mg/L."

28. Standard P2 is amended by:

- (a) adding at the end of sub-subparagraph (3)(b)(i)(D) 'when used as an antioxidant';
- (b) omitting paragraph (4)(e).

29. Standard Q2 is amended by:

(a) omitting subparagraph (5)(b)(i);

(b) omitting from paragraph (6)(a):

'It shall contain not less than 5 g/kg of anhydrous caffeine derived from the coffee.'

(c) omitting from paragraph (7)(a):

'It shall contain not less than 2.5 g/kg of anhydrous caffeine derived from the coffee.'

30. Standard R3 is amended by inserting after clause (6) the following clause:

'(6A) The statement referred to in subparagraph (6)(b)(ii) is not required if the label includes a nutrition information panel.'

31. Standard R4 is amended by adding at the end the following clause:

'(4) The statements referred to in subparagraphs (3)(b)(ii) and (iii) are not required if the label includes a nutrition information panel.'

32. Standard R6 is amended by omitting subparagraph (3)(b)(ii) and substituting the following subparagraphs:

'(ii) other foods, other than sugars and related products as defined in Standard K1 (except to the extent permitted by subparagraph (iia)) and honey as defined in Standard K2;

(iia) maltodextrin, but only to the extent that it is used as a carrier for flavourings;'

33. Standard R7 is amended by:

(a) inserting in paragraph (5)(b) 'subject to paragraph (5)(ba),' before 'in standard type';

(b) inserting after paragraph (5)(b) the following paragraph:

'(ba) in the case of infant formula in packages having a net weight of less than 1 kg - the statements referred to in subparagraphs (5)(b)(ii), (5)(b)(iii), (5)(b)(iv) and (5)(b)(v) in standard type of 1.5 mm;'
