NOTICE UNDER THE COMMONWEALTH ELECTORAL ACT 1902.

Commonwealth Electoral Office, Brisbane, 29th June, 1903.

Objections or suggestions relating to any proposed Division may, in accordance with section 18 of the said Act, be lodged, in writing, with me, at the Commonwealth Electoral Office, Eagle and Queen streets, Brisbane, within 30 days after the publication of this notice.
