NOTICE UNDER THE COMMONWEALTH ELECTORAL ACTS, 1902-1905.

WHEREAS His Excellency the Governor-General has directed that a redistribution of the State of New South Wales into Commonwealth Electoral Divisions shall be made in accordance with the Commonwealth Electoral Acts 1902-1905: And whereas it has been found necessary, in order to comply with the provisions of the said Acts, of the Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act, and of the Representation Act 1905, that the said State be distributed into twenty-seven, in lieu of the now existing twenty-six Electoral Divisions: Public attention is hereby invited to the fact that a Map, with a description of the boundaries, of each of such proposed twenty-seven Divisions is now being, or will shortly be, exhibited at every principal Post-office therein, and that objections or suggestions, relating to the form or boundaries of all, or any, of such proposed Divisions may be lodged, in writing, by post or otherwise, with the Commonwealth Electoral Divisions Re-distribution Commissioner, at the Commonwealth Electoral Office, Denman Chambers, Phillip-street, Sydney, not later than thirty days after the date hereof.
