## NOTIFICATION OF PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS, AND OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE REGULATIONS UNDER THE TRADE MARKS ACT 1905.

Commonwealth of Australia.

Department of Trade and Customs,  
Melbourne, 29th June, 1906.

**P**URSUANT to the *Rules Publication Act* 1903, notice is hereby given—

(1) That His Excellency the Governor-General, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, was, on the twenty-ninth day of June, 1906, pleased to make Provisional Regulations under the *Trade Marks Act* 1905, to come into operation on 2nd July, 1906, which Provisional Regulations may be cited as Statutory Rule 1906, No. 49.

(2) That it is proposed to make Regulations under the *Trade Marks Act* 1905, and that the Provisional Regulations above mentioned are the draft of the proposed Regulations.

(3) That copies of the Provisional Regulations may be purchased at the Government Printing Office, Melbourne, at the price of One shilling and threepence.

(4) That any representations or suggestions made in writing by any person interested will be taken into consideration before finally settling the proposed Regulations.
