WHEREAS by the Customs Act 1901-1914 it is enacted that all goods the importation of which may be prohibited by proclamation are prohibited imports:

Now therefore I, Sir Bonald Craufurd Munro Ferguson, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby prohibit the importation of sugar into the Commonwealth of Australia, except with the consent in writing of the Minister of State for Trade and Customs.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Com-monwealth at Adelaide, this seventh day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fifteen, and in the sixth year of His Majesty's reign.
