NOTIFICATION OF PROVISIONAL REGULATIONS, AND OF THE INTENTION TO MAKE
REGULATIONS UNDER THE *WAR PRECAUTIONS ACT* 1914.

(WAR PRECAUTIONS REGULATIONS (No. 2) 1915—AMENDMENT.)

PURSUANT to the *Rules Publication Act* 1903, notice is hereby given—

- (1) That His Excellency the Governor-General, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, was, on the tenth day of March, 1915, pleased to make a Provisional Regulation under the *War Precautions Act* 1914, to come into operation forthwith, which Provisional Regulation may be cited as Statutory Rules 1915, No. 28.
- (2) That it is proposed, after sixty days after the publication of this notice, to make a Regulation under the *War Precautions Act* 1914, and that the Provisional Regulation above-mentioned is the draft of the proposed Regulation.
- (3) That copies of the Provisional Regulation may be purchased at the Government Printing Office, Melbourne, at the price of threepence.
- (4) That any representations or suggestions made in writing by any person interested will be taken into consideration before finally settling the proposed Regulation.
