DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM PRICES.

I, GEORGE FOSTER PEARCE, Minister of State for Defence, in pursuance of the War Precautions (Prices) Regulations 1916 (Statutory Rules 1916, No. 155), and on the recommendation of the Board, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 15, and shall come into force on the 14th August, 1916.

2. This Order shall apply to the areas in the State of New South Wales specified in the Schedule to this Order.
