INDUSTRIAL BOARD ELECTION REGULATIONS.

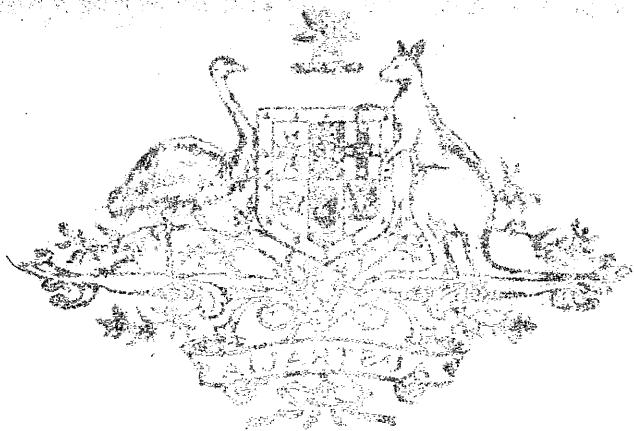
ELECTION OF MEMBERS AND DEPUTIES OF MEMBERS OF BOARD.

I ROBERT GORDON MENZIES, Attorney-General of the Commonwealth, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Industrial Board Election Regulations, do hereby—

- (a) direct that an election by Commonwealth employees and private employees of persons to be members of the Industrial Board, representing Commonwealth employees and private employees, respectively, and of deputies of such members, be held;
- (b) fix the seventh day of June, 1937, as the date on or before which nominations of candidates for election shall be lodged with the Returning Officer, Chief Electoral Office, City, Canberra; and
- (c) fix the twenty-eighth day of June, 1937, as the date on which the poll shall close.
