PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 2152.

Bananas.

IN pursuance of the powers delegated to me by the Commonwealth Prices Commissioner pursuant to regulation 46 of the National Security (Prices) Regulations, I, Horace Eddy Bishop, Second Assistant Prices Commissioner, Prices Branch, Canberra, hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 2152.
- 2. Prices Regulation Order No. 2147 is hereby amended by omitting the First, Second and Third Schedules, and inserting in their stead the First, Second and Third Schedules respectively to this Order.
