NATIONAL SECURITY (ECONOMIC ORGANIZATION) REGULATIONS.

COUNTRY LANDS IN THE STATE OF VICTORIA.

Order under Regulation 6A.

variance of regulation 6A of the National Security (Economic Organization) Regulations, I, Albert Eli Lind, Commissioner of Crown Lands and Survey hereby make the following Order:

I hereby declare that country land specified in the Schedule to this Order to be land suitable for settlement by former members of the Defence Force.

THE SCHEDULE.

County of Moira, being the area within the boundaries hereinafter described; Commencing at the north west angle of allotment 8 section B Parish of Barwo; thence easterly by a maugh; thence northerly by a road to the north west angle of allotment 19 section C, Parish of Strathmerton; thence easterly by a road to the south west angle of allotment 13: easterly by a road to the south west angle of allotment 13: thence northerly by a road to the north west angle of allotment 6; thence north easterly by the eastern boundary of the Numurkah to Strathmerton Railway Reserve to the south boundary of allotment 23 section A; thence easterly by that boundary and northerly by a road to the north west angle of allotment 35, section B; thence easterly by the northern boundary of that allotment and northerly by the western boundary of allotment 34 to the southern boundary of the Strathmerton to Cobram Railway Reserve; thence easterly by that Reserve to the north east angle of allotment 44 sections Strathmerton to Cobram Railway Reserve; thence easterly by that Reserve to the north east angle of allotment 14 section B, Parish of Yarroweyah; thence south easterly by a two chain road to the south east angle of allotment 41 a section A; thence westerly by the southern boundary of that allotment and a road to the north west angle of allotment 25 section D Parish of Strathmerton; thence southerly by a road to the south east angle of allotment 27; thence westerly by a road to the north west angle of allotment 1 section B, parish of Katunga; thence southerly by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 5 section C; thence westerly by a road to the north west angle of allotment 8; thence southerly by a the north west angle of allotment 8; thence southerly by a road to the north east angle of allotment 9; thence westerly by a road to the road from Cobram to Numurkah; thence by a road to the road from Cobram to Numurkan; thence south-westerly by that road to a point in line with the south boundary of allotment 10; thence westerly by a line and that boundary to the north west angle of allotment 11, thence southerly by a road to the north boundary of the Numurkan to Nathalia Railway Reserve; thence north westerly by that Reserve to the west boundary of allotment 24 section A.

Parish of Baulkamaugh; thence northerly by that boundary to the north west angle of the said allotment, thence westerly by a road to the south west angle of allotment 8 section D Parish of Waaia; thence northerly by a road to the north boundary of the Numurkah to Nathalia Railway Reserve; thence westerly by that Reserve to the west boundary of allotment 22 section A; thence northerly by that boundary, westerly by the southern boundary of allotment 20, and southwesterly by the eastern boundaries of allotments 19 and 19A to the northern boundary of the Numurkah to Nathalia Railto the northern boundary of the Numurkah to Nathalia Railway Reserve; thence westerly and north westerly by that Reserve to the western boundary of allotment 4A section D, Parish of Barwo; thence northerly, easterly and northerly by that boundary to the north west angle of the said allotment; thence westerly by a road to the south west angle of allotment 14 section C; thence northerly by a three chain road to the north angle of allotment 5A section B thence generally westerly by the southern boundaries of allotments 5, 6 and 7 to the south west angle of the last mentioned allotment thence westerly by a road and north westerly and westerly by the southern boundaries of allotments 10 and 9 to the south west angle of latter allotment, and thence northerly by a road to the north west angle of allotment 8 section B being the point of commencement.

NATIONAL SECURITY (RATIONING) REGULATIONS. INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION.

IN pursuance of regulation 9 of the National Security (Rationing) Regulations, the Rationing Commission hereby delegates to every person who shall during the continuance of this delegation be holding the office or performing the duties of Personnel Officer in charge of any camp under the control of the Director-General, Department of Works and Housing, appointed under the National Security (Allied Works) Regulations the following power under the National Security (Rationing) Regulations, namely:—

Power to give to any passon who is appointed with first

Power to give to any person who is provided with food in that camp directions, by notice in writing, with respect to the possession, surrender or delivery of any coupon.
