PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 2266. Spirituous Liquors-Shark Bay-Carnarvon Areas-Australia.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the National Security (Prices) Regulations, I, Mortimer Eugene McCarthy, Assistant Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

- 1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 2266.
 - Definitions and Interpretation.
- 2.—(1.) In this Order and the Schedule thereto, unless the contrary intention appears
 - contrary intention appears—

 "Aerated waters" includes cordials;

 "Shark Bay-Carnarvon Areas" means all those areas of Western Australia comprised within a radius of 3 miles from the principal post office of each of the following towns—Shark Bay and Carnarvon;

 "spirituous liquors" means any spirituous or fermented liquors, or any mixture thereof, and includes any mixture thereof with aerated waters;

 "OZ." means a fluid ounce or ounces as the case may be:

 - "small 5-oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing less than 5-oz.;

"5-oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 5 oz. or more but less than 6 oz.;
"6-oz. glass" means any glass or similar container

"6-oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 6 oz. or more but less than 7 oz.;

"7-oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 7 oz. or more but less than 8 oz.;

"8-oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 8 oz. or more but less than 9 oz.;

"9-oz. glass" means any glass or similar container containing 9 oz. or more but less than 10 oz.;

"10-oz. glass or pot" means any glass or similar container containing not less than 10 oz.;

"small nobbler" means any glass or similar container containing less than 13/16th oz.;

"nobbler" means any glass or similar container containing not less than 13/16th oz.;

"reputed quart" means 26 oz.;

"imperial quart" means 26 oz.;

"bottle" means a reputed quart (26 fluid oz.);

"half bottle" means a reputed pint (13 fluid oz.);

"quarter bottle" means a reputed half pint (6½ fluid oz.).

(2.) For the purpose of this Order, where any bottled spirituous liquors are sold without a label bearing the brand and description of that liquor, that liquor shall be deemed not to be of any of the brands or descriptions set out in the Schedule to this Order.

Maximum prices-Liquors specified in Schedule.

3. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which any variety or quantity of spirituous liquors specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold in the Shark Bay-Carnarvon areas to be the prices specified therein.

Sales in dining room, lounge or saloon bar.

4. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum prices at which any spirituous liquors specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold liquors specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold other than by the bottle, half bottle, quarter bottle or flask, by any person in any hotel dining room, lounge or saloon bar in the Shark Bay-Carnarvon areas to be the prices specified in the said Schedule plus an amount equal to the difference between the hotel dining room, lounge or saloon bar prices respectively charged by that person on 15th April, 1942, for any such spirituous liquors and the public bar prices charged by that person for such spirituous liquors on such date. Provided that if in the case of any sale, by reason of the absence of records such difference between the hotel dining room, lounge or saloon bar prices and the public bar prices at the 15th April, 1942, cannot be ascertained the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply and such sale shall be deemed to have been made in the public bar.

Non-listed liquors.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any kind or quantity of spirituous liquors or any mixture thereof, or any mixture of liquids containing any spirituous liquors, for the sale of which a maximum price is not fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order, may be sold by any person

foregoing provisions of this Order, may be sold by any person to be—

(a) in respect of sales of beer, ale, stout or lager (together with any container supplied therewith)—an amount computed at the rate of one halfpenny for each fluid ounce of such beer, ale, stout or lager;

(b) in respect of sales of whisky, brandy, gin, schnapps or rum (together with any container supplied therewith)—an amount computed at the rate of threepence for each fluid ounce of such whisky, brandy, gin, schnapps or rum;

(c) in respect of sales of any spirituous liquors other than those specified in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) hereof or any mixture of spirituous liquors or any mixture of liquids containing spirituous liquors (together with any container supplied therewith)—an amount computed at the rate of one halfpenny for each fluid ounce of such spirituous liquors or mixture:

Provided that if any price calculated under the provisions of this paragraph is not an exact number of pence or halfpence that maximum price shall be computed to the nearest upward halfpenny.

upward halfpenny.

Sales by wholesale.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which any spirituous liquors may be sold by wholesale to be the maximum price fixed for such sale by wholesale other than by such foregoing provisions, subject however, in each case, to the maximum limit imposed by those foregoing provisions.

Exhibition of price list.

7. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any spirituous liquors or any mixture thereof, a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed by the provisions of this Order

shall exhibit in a prominent position in his place of business, or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business and in each of the bars, dining rooms and lounges at such place or places of business, a notice or notices setting forth the maximum prices fixed by this Order for the sale by him of any kind and quantity of such spirituous liquors. I hereby declare that any form of notice shall be deemed to be an approved form if it is otherwise in compliance with regulation 45 of the National Security (Prices) Regulations. (Prices) Regulations.

Fixation of maximum prices by notice.

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum prices at which any spirituous liquors specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 2268. Tobacco, Cigarettes, Cigars, Cigarette Papers—New South Wales.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the National Security (Prices) Regulations, I, Douglas Berry Copland, Commonwealth Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:-

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 2268.

Revocation.

2. Insofar as it relates to the sale by retail of tobacco, cigars and cigarettes in New South Wales, Prices Regulation Order No. 879 is revoked.

Definitions and interpretations.

3.—(1.) In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears-

"Newcastle area" means all that area of New South Wales comprised within the following boundaries— commencing at the coast of New South Wales at Catherine Hill Bay, thence bounded generally on

the south by a direct line to Wangi; thence by a direct line to Millfield; thence bounded generally on the west by a direct line to Branxton; thence bounded generally on the north by a direct line to Woodville; thence by a direct line to Raymond Terrace; thence by a direct line to William Town; thence by a line drawn due east to the coast of New South Wales; thence following the coast of New South Wales to the point of commencement; "Sydney area" means all that area of New South Wales comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Sydney.

(2.) For the purpose of this Order, where the post office or principal post office of any place is situated within 2 miles from the boundary line of the Newcastle area, as defined in sub-paragraph (1.) of this paragraph, then all places within 2 miles of that post office or principal post office, as the case may be, shall be deemed to be within the said Newcastle area.

Maximum prices-Tobaccos, &c., specified in Schedule.

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any kind or brand of tobacco, cigars, cigarettes or cigarette papers specified in the Schedule to this Order, may be sold by retail in New South Wales to be the price specified in that Schedule.

Maximum prices-Tobaccos, &c., not specified in Schedule.

- 5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any kind or brand of tobacco, cigars or cigarettes not specified in the Schedule to this Order, may be sold by retail in New South Wales to be—
 - (a) in respect of tobacco—1s. 1d. per oz.;
 - (b) in respect of cigars—ld. each;
 - (c) in respect of cigarettes—1d. each.

Exhibition of price list.

6. Every prson who sells or has for sale by retail in New South Wales, tobacco, cigars, cigarettes or cigarette papers a maximum price for the sale of which is fixed under the National Security (Prices) Regulations, shall exhibit in his place of business, or, if he has more than one place of business, in each of his places of business, a notice or notices setting forth the maximum prices fixed by this Order for the sale by him by retail of such tobacco, cigars, cigarettes or cigarette papers in a form approved by the Commissioner. I declare that any form of notice shall be deemed to be an approved form if it is otherwise in compliance with regulation 45 of the National Security (Prices) Regulations.

Variation of maximum prices by notice.

7. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which tobacco, cigars, cigarettes or cigarette papers, specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

2. In this Order-

"Secondhand" means used.

Maximum prices.

3. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any secondhand domestic refrigerator of the make and description specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold to be the price specified therein.

Exhibition of price tickets.

4.—(1.) Any person who sells or has for sale, other than by auction, any secondhand domestic refrigerator, shall attach thereto, or display in relation thereto a ticket or label setting forth his selling price thereof.

(2.) Any ticket or label required by sub-paragraph (1.) of this paragraph to be attached to or displayed in relation to any goods shall be in such form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or viewing those goods, and as to be properly associated with such goods.

Advertisements.

5.—(1.) Any person who advertises a secondhand domestic refrigerator for sale, shall include in such advertisement the following particulars:-

(a) the name and address of the advertiser;
(b) the make and description of such secondhand refrigerator;
(c) the maximum price fixed under the National Security (Prices) Regulations for the sale of that secondhand refrigerator;
(d) the price which he intends to accept for such secondhand refrigerator (hereinafter referred to as the selling price).

(2.) Such advertisement may be in the following form:-

Variation of maximum prices by notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any secondhand domestic refrigerator specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Meat-South Australia.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the National Security (Prices) Regulations, I, Mortimer Eugene McCarthy, Assistant Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 2263.

Application.

2. This Order shall operate as from 27th September, 1945.

Revocation.

3. Prices Regulation Order No. 1565 as amended by Prices Regulation Orders Nos. 1576, 1596, 1626, 1678, 1693, 1740, 1765, 1819, 1848, 1895, 1926, 1957, 2022, 2079, 2107 and 2130 is hereby revoked.

Definitions and Interpretation.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears-

In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
"The Adelaide metropolitan area" means all that area comprised within a radius of twenty-five miles from the General Post Office, Adelaide, South Australia.
"Prevailing margin of gross profit" means, in relation to the sale by any person of meat of any cut or class, the actual amount in money of gross profit obtained by that person upon the sale of meat of that cut or class on the 26th day of February, 1943, upon substantially the same terms and conditions, or if no sale of meat of such cut or class was made by that person upon such date upon substantially the same terms and upon such date upon substantially the same terms and conditions, then the last preceding date upon which a sale of meat of that cut or class was made by that person upon substantially the same terms and conditions.

conditions.

"Prevailing price" means, in relation to the sale of meat of any cut or class by any person, the price at which that person sold meat of that cut or class on 26th February. 1943, upon substantially the same terms and conditions, or if no sale of meat of that cut or class was made by that person upon that date on substantially the same terms and conditions, then the last preceding date upon which a sale was made by that person of meat of that cut or class upon substantially the same terms and conditions.

tially the same terms and conditions.

5. For the purpose of this Order reference to the weight of any meat shall be construed as a reference to the dressed weight of that meat.

Sales by wholesale—South Australia (Schedule).

6. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which the classes of meat specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by the carcass by wholesale in the State of South Australia (including the Adelaide metropolitan area) to be—

(a) where delivery is made to the purchaser's premises—the prices specified in that Schedule; or
(b) where delivery is not made to the unrchaser's premises—the prices specified in that Schedule less an amount calculated at the rate of one farthing per lb. for every twenty-five miles, or part thereof, by which the seller's premises are distant from the nurchaser's premises. purchaser's premises.

7. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which the classes of meat specified in the Second Schedule to this Order may be sold by wholesale by the carcass in the State of South Australia (including the Adelaide metropolitan area) to be the prices specified in that Schedule.

Sales by wholesale—Adelaide metropolitan area (Schedule).

8. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which meat of any class specified in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order may be sold by the carcass by wholesale in the Adelaide metropolitan area to be-

(a) where delivery is made to the purchaser's premises—
the prices specified in that Schedule;
(b) where delivery is not made to the purchaser's
premises—the prices specified in that Schedule less
an amount calculated at the rate of one farthing per pound for every twenty-five miles or part thereof by which the seller's premises are distant from the purchaser's premises.

Portions of a carcass.

9, I fix and declare the maximum price at which any portion or out of a carcass of meat, a maximum price for the sale of which by the carcass is fixed by paragraphs 6, 7 or 8 of this Order, may be sold by wholesale to be such amount that the maximum price of that portion or cut together with the price of the portions or cuts of that carcass previously sold shall equal the maximum price fixed for the sale of the whole carcass.

Sales by wholesale—Offal meat (Schedule).

10. I fix and declare the maximum price at which the classes of meat specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order may be sold by wholesale in the State of South Australia to be the prices specified in that Schedule.

Other sales by wholesale.

11. I fix and declare the maximum price at which meat of any class may be sold by any person by wholesale in the State of South Australia where a maximum price is not fixed for such sale by paragraphs 6, 7, 8, 9 or 10 of this Order to be—

(a) the prevailing price for the sale of that class of meat

by that person, or

(b) the cost to such person of such meat plus the prevailing margin of gross profit for sales of meat of that class by that person,

whichever is the lesser.

Sales by retail-South Australia (other than Adelaide metropolitan area).

12. I fix and declare the maximum price at which meat of any cut or class may be sold by any person by retail in the State of South Australia, other than in the Adelaide metropolitan area, to be—

- (a) the prevailing price for the sale of that cut or class of meat by that person, or where such cut or class of meat is specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order, the prevailing price for the sale of that cut or class of meat by that person plus the amount per pound specified in the second column of that Schedule, or less the amount per pound specified in the third column of that Schedule, opposite thereto, as the case may be, or
- (b) the cost of such meat to that person plus the prevailing margin of gross profit for sales of meat of such cut or class by that person,

whichever is the lesser:

Provided that the prices so specified for sales outside the Adelaide metropolitan area shall—

- (i) where delivery is made to a purchaser's premises which are not within the boundaries of any town or city and which are also greater than 1 mile distant from the seller's premises; and
- (ii) the delivery charge is separately recorded on a docket delivered in relation to the meat be subject in each case to the addition of a delivery charge of one penny per pound.

Sales by retail-Adelaide metropolitan area.

13. I fix and declare the maximum price at which meat of the classes and cuts specified in the Sixth Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail in the Adelaide metropolitan area to be the prices specified in that Schedule.

Other sales by retail-Adelaide metropolitan area.

- 14. I fix and declare the maximum price at which meat of any class or cut a maximum price for which is not fixed by paragraph 13 of this Order may be sold by any person by retail in the Adelaide metropolitan area to be—
 - (a) the prevailing price for the sale of that class or cut of meat by that person, or
 - (b) the cost to that person of such meat plus the prevailing margin of gross profit for sales of meat of that class or cut by that person,

whichever is the lesser.

General.

- 15. For the purpose of this Order if a person operates more than one place of business he shall in respect of each place of business be deemed to be a separate seller.
- 16. Notwithstanding anything contained in the foregoing provisions of this Order where a seller of any meat has customarily allowed any difference in price—
 - (a) to any person or to persons included in any class of persons; or
 - (b) in respect of sales of certain quantities of meat, the maximum price fixed by or under this Order in respect of that meat shall, in the case of sales to such person or persons or of such quantities, be reduced by the allowance of that difference:

Provided that in the case of any sale by retail, it shall not be necessary to make any such allowance to a greater extent than one halfpenny per pound.

17. For the purpose of this Order where any business, in the carrying on of which any class or cut of meat is sold, or the assets of that business are transferred (by sale or otherwise) after the 26th day of February, 1943, and the

transferee carries on such business at the same place of business, then notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which meat of such class or cut may be sold by the transferee in respect of such place of business to be the maximum price fixed by the forgoing provisions of this Order for the sale of that class or cut of meat by the transferor in respect of such place of business.

Variation of maximum prices by notice.

18. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order-

- (a) I declare the maximum price at which meat of any class or cut specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
- (b) All notices given in pursuance of any Prices Regulation Order revoked by paragraph (3.) of this Order other than notices which fix a retail price for any class or cut of meat specified in the first column of the Sixth Schedule to this Order greater than the price set out opposite that class or cut in the second column of that Schedule, which are in force at the commencement of this Order shall be deemed to have been given under Order shall be deemed to have been given under this Order.

Exhibition of price lists.

19.—(1.) Every trader who sells or has for sale by retail any meat shall exhibit in a prominent place in his shop or if he has more than one shop in each of his shops a notice setting forth the maximum price fixed from time to time by or under the provisions of this or any subsequent Order for the sale by him of any class or cut of meat in the form approved by the Commissioner. I hereby approve of the following form of such notice that is to say—a notice not less than 17 inches long and not less than 11 inches wide, having printed thereon in clear printer's type all the classes or cuts of meat which the trader sells or has for sale and the maximum prices fixed by or under this Order in relation thereto.

(2.) For the purpose of the last preceding sub-paragraph the amount added for delivery in pursuance of the foregoing provision of this Order shall not be deemed to be part of the maximum price, but where any such charge is permitted in relation to the sale of meat by any person under those provisions of this Order shall not be deemed to be part of the type at the foot of the notice referred to in the last preceding sub-paragraph:-

"The prices referred to in this list are subject to the addition of one penny per pound in each case where delivery is made to a purchaser's premises outside this town (or city) and are distant more than I mile from these premises."
