NATIONAL SECURITY (PRICES) REGULATIONS. PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 2287.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the National Security (Prices) Regulations, I, Mortimer Eugene McCarthy, Assistant Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

- Citation.
 1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 2287.
- Revocation.

 2. Prices Regulation Orders Nos. 2207 and 2220 are hereby revoked.
 - Definitions.
 - 3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
 "canned fish" means fish canned in Australia.
 "prescribed area" means the Adelaide, Brisbane, Hobart,
 Melbourne, Perth or Sydney metropolitan area, as
 defined in Prices Regulation Order No. 1598.

- Maximum prices.
 4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any of the varieties of canned fish specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold to be-

 - (a) where delivery is made in a prescribed area—the price specified in that Schedule; or

 (b) where delivery is made outside the prescribed areas—the price specified in the said Schedule plus cost of transport from the nearest prescribed area to

the place of delivery:

Provided that, in the case of sales by the manufacturer or sales by wholesale, the maximum price so fixed shall, where payment is made within thirty days from the date of delivery be subject to a reduction of two and one-half per centum.

Variation of maximum prices by notice.

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which canned fish specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Kiln-Dried and Air-seasoned Hardwood Timber-Melbourne. IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the National Security (Prices) Regulations, I, Mortimer Eugene McCarthy, Assistant Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 2292.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 1662 is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order and the Schedule thereto, unless the contrary intention appears

"Melbourne metropolitan area" means all that area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

"Merchantable quality" means, in relation to any sale of kiln dried and reconditioned, air-seasoned or part seasoned hardwood timber, that such timber is sound, quartersawn truewood, free from defects other than—

(a) on the face, tight gum veins not more than 3/32nds inch wide, with a combined length not exceeding 3 feet per square foot of face area of the board, but 20 per centum thereof shall be allowed 9 feet of the combined length per square foot of face area of the

board;
(b) on the face, three holes not greater than
1/16th inch diameter per square foot of face area of the board, not more than three being grouped in any four square inches; (c) on the face, one sound tight knot not greater

than \(\frac{1}{4} \) inch diameter per three square feet of the face area of the board;

(d) one inch spring per 12 feet;

"select quality" means, in relation to any sale of kilndried and reconditioned, air-seasoned, or part seasoned hardwood timber, that such timber is sound quarter-sawn truewood, free on the face from all defects other than the following tolerance:—

(a) on the face, tight gum veins not more than 1/32nd inch wide, individual lengths not exceeding 1 inch per square foot of the face area of the board

(b) on the face, one hole not greater than 1/16th inch diameter per square foot of face area of the board, not more than three being grouped

in any four square inches; (c) one inch spring per 12 feet length.

"kiln-dried and reconditioned hardwood" means hardwood timber having a moisture content not exceeding 14 per centum; "air-seasoned hardwood" means hardwood timber having

a moisture content not exceeding 18 per centum;
"part-seasoned hardwood" means hardwood timber
having a moisture content not exceeding 28 per

"hardwood sold ex yard" means hardwood timber conforming to definitions shown above which has been stacked in the seller's yard.

Maximum prices.

4. I fix and declare the maximum prices at which any of the hardwood specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold in the Melbourne metropolitan area to any person other than a reseller of those hardwoods to be—

(a) in respect of sales ex yard—the prices specified in that Schedule; or

(b) in respect of sales other than ex yard—the price paid or payable, or the maximum price fixed for the sale of that timber to the seller, whichever is the lesser, plus 10 per centum thereof.

Dressing charges, cartage.

5. I fix and declare the maximum rates at which the services of dressing or carting any of the hardwoods referred to in paragraph 4 of this Order, may be supplied by a reseller of such hardwoods to be the rates specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.

Fixation of maximum prices by notice.

6. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum prices at which kiln-dried and reconditioned hardwood, air-seasoned hardwood and part-seasoned

hardwood specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such prices as are fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Boot and Shoe Repairs-Queensland.

N pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the National Security (Prices) Regulations, I, Mortimer Eugene McCarthy, Assistant Prices Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 2291.

Maximum Rates.

2. I fix and declare the maximum rate at which the kinds of service of boot or shoe repairing set out in the Schedule to this Order, including all the materials therefor, may be supplied by any person by retail in Queensland to be the rate set out in that Schedule opposite each such kind of boot or shoe repairing.

Variation of maximum rates by notice.

3. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order I declare the maximum rate at which any kind of service of boot or shoe repairing specified in a notice in pursuance of this paragraph, may be supplied by any person in Queensland, to whom such notice is given to be such rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Exhibition of price list.

4. Every person who supplies or offers to supply any kind, of service of boot or shoe repairing, a maximum rate for the supply of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order shall exhibit in a prominent position in his shop, or if he has more than one shop in each of his shops a notice setting forth the maximum rate fixed by the provisions of this Order for the supply by him of that kind of service of boot or shoe repairing. I hereby declare that any form of notice shall be deemed to be an approved form if it is otherwise in compliance with regulation 45 of the National Security (Prices) Regulations.
