COUNTRY LANDS IN THE STATE OF VICTORIA.

Order under Regulation 6A.

IN pursuance of regulation 6A of the National Security (Economic Organization) Regulations, I, Leslie William Galvin, Commissioner of Crown Lands and Survey, hereby make the following Order:—

I hereby declare that country land specified in the Schedule to this Order to be land suitable for settlement by former members of the Defence Force.

All that piece of land comprising 237 acres 3 roods 32 perches, being allotment 6, Section 2, Parish of Tintaldra County of Benambra.

NATIONAL SECURITY (EXTERNAL TERRITORIES) REGULATIONS.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 24.

I, EDWARD JOHN WARD, Minister of State for External Territories, in pursuance of the powers conferred by regulation 24 of the National Security (External Territories) Regulations, hereby fix the fifteenth day of December, 1945, as the date of termination of the suspension of publicans licences granted under the *Liquor Ordinance* 1911-1940 of the Territory of Papua and the *Liquor Ordinance* 1931-1938 of the Territory of New Guinea, and of the leases of land in respect of which any such licence is held, in the following area:—

(1) Territory of Papua.

(2) Morobe District.—That part of the Territory of New Guinea commencing at the point of intersection of the middle thread of the Markham River with the shore of the Huon Gulf at high-water mark and bounded thence on the north-east by a straight line south-easterly to the point of intersection of the Meridian 148 degrees 15 minutes east longitude with the parallel 7 degrees south latitude thence on the east by part of the Meridian 148 degrees 15 minutes east longitude

south to its point of intersection with the Parallel 8 degrees south latitude, thence on the south by part of the Parallel 8 degrees south latitude west to its point of intersection with the Meridian 147 degrees east longitude, being also a point on the territorial boundary between the Territories of New Guinea and Papua, thence on the south-west by part of the said territorial boundary north-westerly to the point of intersection with the Parallel 6 degrees 47 minutes of south latitude, thence on the north-west by a straight line north-easterly to the point of intersection of the Parallel 6 degrees 20 minutes south latitude with the middle thread of the Markham River, thence generally on the north-east by the said middle thread of the Markham River, downstream to the point of commencement.

WHEREAS it is provided by section two of the *Tuberculosis Act* 1945 that that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

Now therefore I, Henry William Frederick Albert, Duke of Gloucester, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby fix the first day of January, One thousand nine hundred and forty-six, as the date on which the *Tuberculosis Act* 1945 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Commonwealth this thirteenth day of December in the year of our (L.S.) Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-five, and in the tenth year of His Majesty's reign.
