ORDER AMENDING THE CONTROL OF NEW MOTOR CARS ORDER.

I EDWARD JOHN WARD, the Minister of State for Transport, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 7 of the *Defence (Transitional Provisions) Act 1946-1947*, hereby make the following Order:—

Definitions.

Paragraph 2 of the Control of New Motor Cars Order is amended by inserting in the definition of "Motor car", after the word "Order", the words "or a motor vehicle not exceeding 12 horse-power".

ORDER AMENDING THE CONTROL OF NEW COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES ORDER.

I EDWARD JOHN WARD, the Minister of State for Transport, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 7 of the *Defence (Transitional Provisions) Act 1946-1947*, hereby make the following Order:—

Interpretation.

Paragraph 2 of the Control of New Commercial Motor Vehicles Order is amended by inserting in the definition of "commercial motor vehicle", after the word "goods", the words "(not being a motor vehicle having a capacity of not less than 21 hundredweight or not exceeding 12 horse-power)".
