## PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of

By His Excellency the Governor-  
General in and over the Common-  
wealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by sub-section (1.) of section nine A of the *Customs Tariff* 1933-1949 it is enacted that the Governor-General may, from time to time, by proclamation, declare that, from a time and date specified in the proclamation, the Intermediate Tariff shall apply to such goods specified in the proclamation as are the produce or manufacture of any British or foreign country specified in the proclamation:

And whereas by sub-section (3.) of the said section nine A it is provided that a proclamation issued in pursuance of sub-section (1.) of the said section nine A may be revoked or varied by further proclamation:

And whereas Customs Proclamation No. 755 made on the seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and published in the *Gazette* on the seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and Customs Proclamation No. 762 made on the fifth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and published in the *Gazette* on the thirteenth day of October, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, were issued in pursuance of the said sub-section:

And whereas by paragraph (2.) of Customs Tariff Proposals No. 2 introduced into the House of Representatives on the seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, it is provided that the Governor-General, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, may, from time to time, by proclamation, declare that, from a time and date specified in the proclamation, the Intermediate Tariff shall apply to such goods specified in the proclamation as are the produce or manufacture of any British or foreign country specified in the proclamation:

And whereas by sub-section (2.) of section four of the *Customs Tariff* 1949, it is enacted that the power conferred by sub-section (3.) of section nine A of the *Customs Tariff* 1933-1949, to issue a proclamation revoking or varying a proclamation issued in pursuance of sub-section (1.) of that section shall include a power to revoke or vary any proclamation issued in pursuance of paragraph (2.) of the said Customs Tariff Proposals No. 2:

And whereas Customs Proclamation No. 758 made on the seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and published in the *Gazette* on the seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, was issued in pursuance of paragraph (2.) of the said Customs Tariff Proposals No. 2:

And whereas it is desirable to revoke the said proclamations and make other provision in lieu thereof:

And whereas by Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the eleventh day of May, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, it is provided, *inter alia*, that the Governor-General, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, may, from time to time, by proclamation, declare that, from a time and date specified in the proclamation, the Intermediate Tariff shall apply to such goods specified in the proclamation as are the produce or manufacture of any British or foreign country specified in the proclamation:

And whereas it is desirable to specify a time and date from which rates of duty set out in the Schedule to the Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the eleventh day of May, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, in the column headed "Intermediate Tariff", shall apply to certain goods the produce or manufacture of certain British or foreign countries:

Now therefore I, William John McKell, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby revoke Customs Proclamations Nos. 755, 758 and 762 as from nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Australian Capital Territory, on the twelfth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, and do hereby declare that, from the said time on the said date, the Intermediate Tariff shall apply to such goods specified in the First Schedule to this proclamation as are the produce or manufacture of any British or foreign country specified in the Second Schedule to this proclamation.

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by the *Customs Tariff (Primage Duties) 1934* it is provided that, in addition to the duties of Customs collected in accordance with any other law of the Commonwealth for the time being in force, primage duties are imposed at the rates and on the goods specified in the Schedule to that Act (except such goods as are by or under the said Schedule exempt from primage duty):

And whereas, under the said Schedule, goods which are from time to time exempt from primage duty by Proclamation made by the Governor-General acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council and published in the *Gazette* are exempt from primage duty:

And whereas, by Customs Proclamation No. 756 made on the seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and published in the *Gazette* on the seventh day of September, One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, certain goods were exempted from primage duty:

And whereas it is desirable to revoke the said Proclamation and make other provision in lieu thereof:

Now therefore I, William John McKell, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby revoke the said Proclamation, as from nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Australian Capital Territory on the twelfth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and fifty, and do hereby exempt from primage duty, as from the said time on the said date, the goods specified in the First Schedule to this Proclamation.
