**CANBERRA SEWERAGE AND WATER SUPPLY
REGULATIONS.**

I GORDON FREETH, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by Regulation 91 of the Canberra Sewerage and Water Supply Regulations hereby prohibit any person from using, for the purpose of watering a grassed area, lawn, garden or other similar area by means of a hose, fixed for the time being in one position, sprinkler, spray or other similar device, water supplied by the Commonwealth, except between the hours of 6 o'clock in the morning and 3 o'clock in the afternoon of any day.
