PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of Australia to wit. W. J. SLIM Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS it is enacted by sub-section (2.) of section two of the Public Service Act 1957 that sections four, seven, fourteen, twenty-three and twenty-four of that Act shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

Now therefore I, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby fix the Twentieth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and fiftynine, as the date on which sections four, seven, fourteen, twenty-three and twenty-four of the Public Service Act 1957 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth this 20th day of February, in the year of our (L.S.)

Lord, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, and in the eighth year of Her Majesty's reign.
