QUARANTINE PROCLAMATION No. 64A.

Commonwealth of
Australia to wit.
W. J. SLIM

By His Excellency the Governor-General
in and over the Commonwealth of
Australia.

WHEREAS by section thirteen of the Quarantine Act 1908-1950 it is enacted, amongst other things, that the Governor-General may, by proclamation, prohibit the importation into Australia of any animals or any parts of animals, and that the power of prohibition under that section shall extend to authorize prohibition generally or with limitations as to place and subject matter, and either absolutely or subject to any specified conditions or restrictions:

And whereas by Quarantine Proclamation No. 63A published in the Gazette on the twenty-seventh day of November, One thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight, the importation into Australia of animals, other than certain specified animals, was prohibited and the importation of certain of those specified animals was, with limitations as to place and subject to specified conditions and restrictions, prohibited:

And whereas it is desirable to amend Quarantine Proclamation No. 63A:

Now therefore I, Sir William Joseph Slim, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby amend Quarantine Proclamation No. 63A—

- (a) by omitting from the second column of the first Schedule to that Proclamation all the words specified in that column opposite to the description "2. Dogs and cats" in the first column of that Schedule and inserting in their stead the words—

"The animals shall not be imported from a country other than Great Britain, the Channel Islands, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland or New Zealand";

- (b) by omitting from the second column of the First Schedule to that Proclamation all the words specified in that column opposite to the description "9. Swine" in the first column of that Schedule and inserting in their stead the words—

"Swine shall not be imported from a country other than New Zealand, Northern Ireland or the Republic of Ireland"; and

- (c) by inserting in the Second Schedule to that Proclamation, after paragraph 2, the following paragraph:—

"2A. A dog or cat shall not be imported from the Channel Islands unless it is shipped for Australia at a port in Great Britain specified in the last preceding paragraph."
