Customs Act 1901-1963

CUSTOMS BY-LAWS Nos. 1621-1622.

KENNETH McCOLL ANDERSON, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of section 271 of the Customs Act 1901-1963, hereby make the following By-laws set out in the Schedule hereto.

THE SCHEDULE.

By-law No. 1621.

Item 359 (D)(3).

- 1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 1621.
- 2. By-law No. 1144, published in Gazette No. 21, dated 7th March, 1963, as amended, is further amended by-
 - (a) deleting from the list of goods in the Table to paragraph 3 excluded from admission under Tariff Item 359 (D)(3), the following:-
 - " brushes, &c."
 - "commutators, &c."
 "distributors, &c."
 "generators, &c."

 - "starting motors, &c."
 - "voltage regulators, &c."

but Tariff Item 359 (D) (3) applies to-

Unassembled parts for distributors

Unassembled parts for generators, 6 volt or 12 volt rating, other than brushes or commutators Unassembled parts for starting motors, 6 volt or 12

volt rating, other than brushes or commutators

Unassembled parts for voltage regulators, automatic, for 6 volt or 12 volt systems

provided they are-

in direct transit to Australia on 31st July, 1964, and are entered for home consumption on arrival; or in bond in Australia on 31st July, 1964, and are entered for home consumption on or before 31st

August, 1964.

(b) adding to the list of goods included in the Table to paragraph 3, excluded from admission under Tariff Item 359 (D) (3), the following:-

distributors

generators, 6 volt or 12 volt rating

starting motors, 6 volt or 12 volt rating

voltage regulators, automatic, for 6 volt or 12 volt systems

By-law No. 1622.

Item 449 (A) (1).

- 1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. 1622.
- 2. By-law No. 203, published in Gazette No. 23, dated 10th March, 1961, as amended, is further amended by-
 - (a) deleting from the list of goods in Section 1 to which Tariff Item 449 (A) (1) applies, under the heading "Electrical machines and appliances, viz." the following:-
 - "Distributor parts, high tension, &c."
 - "Dynamo-Magnetos, &c."

 "Dynamo parts, &c."

 - "Motor parts, starting, &c."

but Tariff Item 449 (A)(1) applies to such goods provided they are-

- in direct transit to Australia on 31st July, 1964, and are entered for home consumption on arrival; or
- in bond in Australia on 31st July, 1964, and are entered for home consumption on or before 31st August, 1964.
- (b) deleting from the list of goods in Section 3 to which Tariff Item 449 (A)(1) applies, under the heading "Electrical —" the reference to "Blocks composed of a mixture &c." but Tariff Item 449 (A)(1) applies to such goods provided they are
 - in direct transit to Australia on 31st July, 1964, and are entered for home consumption on arrival; or
 - in bond in Australia on 31st July, 1964, and are entered for home consumption on or before 31st August, 1964.
