PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of
Australia to wit
DE L'ISLE
Governor-General.

By His Excellency the Governor-General
in and over the Commonwealth of
Australia.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 2 of the Broadcasting and Television Act 1964 that the provisions of that Act, other than sections 1 and 2 and sub-sections (1.) and (2.) of section 7, shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by Proclamation, being a date later than the first day of October, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-four:

NOW THEREFORE I, William Philip, Viscount De L'Isle, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby fix the first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-five, as the date on which the provisions of that Act, other than sections 1 and 2 and sub-sections (1.) and (2.) of section 7, shall come into operation.
