NOTICE UNDER SECTION 7.

IN pursuance of Section 7 of the Customs Tariff (Dumping and Subsidies) Act 1961, I, Kenneth McColl Anderson, Minister of State for Customs and Excise hereby notify that, after inquiry and report by the Tariff Board, I am satisfied that Phosphoric Acid has been or is being sold to an importer in Australia at an export price which is less than the normal value of the goods at the date of exportation and that injury may thereby be caused or threatened to an Australian industry.

This notice may be cited as "Dumping and Subsidies Act Notice No. 32" and shall have effect in relation to all such goods exported on and after 13th April, 1964.
