TERRITORY OF COCOS (KEELING) ISLANDS

ORDER UNDER SECTION 55 (1) OF THE IMMIGRATION ORDINANCE OF THE COLONY OF SINGAPORE IN ITS APPLICATION TO THE TERRITORY

IN pursuance of sub-section (1) of section 55 of the Immigration Ordinance of the Colony of Singapore in its application to the Territory, I, Charles Edward Barnes, the Minister of State for External Territories, by this Order, do hereby exempt from the provisions of section 6 of Part II and all of Part III of the said Ordinance the following classes of persons:—

Persons entering the Territory for the purpose of using the aerodrome or other facilities on West Island and who are either—

- (a) members of the United States Forces as defined in Article 1 of the Agreement of the 9th May, 1963, between the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia and the Government of the United States of America covering the status of United States Forces in Australia;
- (b) members of the civilian component as defined in the said Agreement travelling to the Territory by special transport; or
- (c) dependants as defined in the said Agreement travelling to the Territory by special transport.
