# Customs Act 1901–1968 NOTICE OF INTENTION TO PROPOSE CUSTOMS TARIFF ALTERATION NOTICE No. 9 (1968)

IN pursuance of section 273EA of the Customs Act 1901-1968, I, MALCOLM FOX SCOTT, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, hereby give notice that it is intended, within seven sitting days of the House of Representatives after the date of the publication of this notice in the Gazette, to propose in the Parliament a Customs Tariff alteration in accordance with the particulars specified in the Schedule to this notice and operating on and from the second day of August, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight.

# Customs Act 1901-1968 CUSTOMS TARIFF 1966-1968 FIRST SCHEDULE

## By-laws Nos F285 and F286

I, MALCOLM FOX SCOTT, Minister of State for Customs and Excise, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by Part XVI. of the Customs Act 1901-1968, and all other enabling powers, hereby make the by-laws set out in the Schedule hereto.

## THE SCHEDULE

## By-law No. F285

- Paragraph 40.02.91
- 1. This by-law may be cited as Customs By-law No. F285.

  2. Paragraph 40.02.91 in Part II. of the First Schedule to the

  Latex, to which paragraph 40.02.99 in Part II. of the First
  Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1968 otherwise applies
  - Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1968 otherwise applies

    Latex, to which paragraph 40.02.92 in Part II. of the First

    Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1968 otherwise applies,
    for use otherwise than in:
    - (a) paper coating:
    - (h) leather finishing:
    - (c) the manufacture of paints, enamels or varnishes; or
    - (d) floor polish,
  - under security
  - Synthetic rubber to which paragraph 40.02.99 in Part II. of the First Schedule to the Customs Tariff 1966-1968 otherwise applies, that is entered for home consumption on or before 31 December 1968.

- 3. In this by-law 'security' means that security shall be given to and to the satisfaction of the Collector and that the giving of such security is a condition subject to which this item applies to the goods or the class or kind of goods so conditioned.

- under security

  3. In this by-law 'security' means that security shall be given
  to and to the satisfaction of the Collector and that the giving of
  such security is a condition subject to which this item applies to
- the goods or the class or kind of goods so conditioned.

#### PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of Australia to wit. CASEY Governor-General. By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS a proposed law entitled "An Act to limit the matters in which Special Leave of Appeal from the High Court of Australia to Her Majesty in Council may be asked and to exclude appeals to Her Majesty in Council from other Federal Courts and from the Supreme Courts of the Territories of the Commonwealth."

AND WHEREAS, upon the proposed law being on the seventeenth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, presented to me for the Royal Assent, I reserved the proposed law for the signification of Her Majesty's pleasure:

AND WHEREAS the signification of Her Majesty's pleasure has been communicated to me:

NOW THEREFORE I, Richard Gardiner, Baron Casey, the Governor-General aforesaid do hereby proclaim and make known that Her Majesty was, on the tenth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, pleased to assent to the proposed law

GIVEN under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth of Australia this thirtieth day of July, in the year (L.S.) of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, and in the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's reign.
