WHEREAS by section 2 of the Navigation Act 1968 it is provided, amongst other things, that the provisions of that Act, other than sections 1, 2 and 15, shall come into operation on a date to be fixed by Proclamation:

NOW THEREFORE I, Richard Gardiner, Baron Casey, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, hereby fix the twenty-ninth day of October,

1968, as the date on which the provisions of that Act, other than sections 1, 2 and 15, shall come into operation.
