PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of Australia to wit PAUL HASLUCK Governor-General. By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia.

WHEREAS by Proclamation published in the Gazette on the sixth day of March, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, Monday, the sixteenth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, was, in pursuance of sub-section (1.) of section 76 of the Public Service Act 1922-1968, appointed to be observed as a holiday in the Commonwealth Offices in the Australian Capital Territory, the Northern Territory, the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, the Territory of Norfolk Island and the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands in lieu of Monday, the twenty-first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine:

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to revoke that Proclamation and make other provision in its stead:

NOW THEREFORE I, Sir Paul Meernaa Caedwalla Hasluck, the Governor-General aforesaid, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, do hereby—

(a) revoke that Proclamation; and

- (b) proclaim that, in lieu of the twenty-first day of April, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, being the anniversary of the birthday of the Sovereign—
 - (i) the ninth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, shall be observed as a holiday in the Commonwealth Service in the Territory of Papua and the Territory of New Guinea; and
 - (ii) the sixteenth day of June, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, shall be observed as a holiday in the Commonwealth Service in the Australian Capital Territory, the Northern Territory of Australia, Norfolk Island and the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands.

Given under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth this sixth day of June in the year of Our Lord

(L.S.) One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign.
