PROCLAMATION

Commonwealth of Australia to wit By His Excellency the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of

PAUL HASLUCK

Governor-General.

WHEREAS by section five of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Australia it is, amongst other things, provided that the Governor-General may, by Proclamation, dissolve the House of Representatives:

Now therefore I, Sir Paul Meernaa Caedwalla Hasluck, the Governor-General aforesaid, do by this my Proclamation dissolve the House of Representatives as at noon on the twenty-ninth day of September, One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine:

And I discharge senators from attendance as from that time on that date and until the day appointed for holding the next session of the Parliament.

GIVEN under my Hand and the Great Seal of the Commonwealth this twenty-ninth day of September in the year of (L.S.) our Lord One thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's reign.
